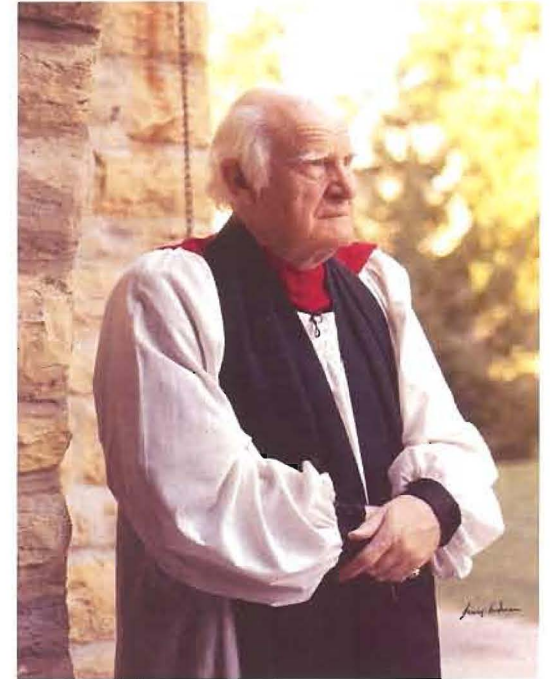

During the first five years of Dean Munday's tenure, the residential student body of Nashotah

House more than doubled, the total student body more than tripled, and the seminary moved toward better financial health. An increase in students brings vitality and efficiency of operation, however, concurrently the need for financial resources increases dramatically, especially for student scholarships.

The Archbishop Michael Ramsey Society:

The Archbishop Michael Ramsey Society is an association of lay individuals wishing to join with the Alumni Association in showing appreciation for the mission of Nashotah House by providing financial support to Nashotah House and then, through the activities of the Society, to participate in the spiritual resources and activities Nashotah House has to offer.
